Information about the PROSPR 1 Cervical Public Use Data Sets:

Variables in the PROSPR 1 Cervical Cancer Public Use Data Set are shown in an Excel spreadsheet. A brief description of each variable is provided as well.

The file has participant information on the population of every individual enrolled in 2012 at a PROSPR 1 Cervical site EXCEPT the University of New Mexico site. Each record reflects one unique individual. Screening variables are returned only for individuals with a screening Pap test in 2012. A Pap test is considered screening if at least 300 days have passed since the most recent prior Pap test, or there is no prior Pap.
