SEER-Medicare- current

- 2020 release
 - Diagnosis years: 1999-2017
 - Claims: 1999-2018
 - Inpatient, Outpatient, Carrier, Hospice, Home Health, Durable Medical Equipment, Part D
 - Part D Characteristics Files
 - Plan - e.g., plan type, premium, cost-sharing
 - Prescriber -e.g., demographics, specialty,
 - Pharmacy -e.g., type: mail-order, independent, chain

SEER-Medicare- future

- Next couple years potentially add:
 - Medicare Advantage Encounter Data
 - Inpatient, Outpatient, Carrier, SNF, Durable Medical Equipment
 - Financial measures
 - Beneficiary
 - Aggregate- Zip code, Census tract
 - Individual level
 - Provider- e.g., participation in payment and delivery system models like accountable care organizations (ACOs)
 - Decrease time lag

SEER-Medicare- data release

- Currently
 - Data files based on place of service-e.g., inpatient, outpatient
 - Cumbersome, large files
- Developing new SEER-Medicare “products”
 - Claims repackaged to create more intuitive files based on:
 - Type of care- e.g., systemic therapy, radiation, surgery
 - Type of measure-e.g., comorbidity, cost
 - Implications for data request cost and study timeline

SEER-Medicaid

- Initial release
 - Diagnosis years: 2006-2013
 - Medicaid enrollment: monthly 2006-2013
 - All 50 states and DC
- Next release (2+yrs)
 - More recent diagnosis years
 - Add claims/encounter data



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
